He conducted and directed transnational criminal investigations collaboratively with foreign law enforcement officials in Asia, the Caribbean and South America.

William was educated at the University of Illinois at Chicago (BA), Chicago State University (MS), National Intelligence University (MS), and American University (MA). He is a resident War College graduate and completed national security programs at MIT, and Harvard, George Washington and Syracuse Universities.
